How to set-up your 2-factor authenticator?


To access your TSS account, you must add a 2-factor authenticator to protect your account. Note that no personal information is shared between the third-party application and the Government of Canada.

A. How to set-up your 2-factor authenticator on a mobile device (smartphone or tablet)

Click "Set up your mobile device".



Read the terms and conditions and click "I accept".




